The winning pavilion will be built in scale 1:1 inside the Dome of Visions, a structure that results from a collaboration between NCC and KTH. The Dome of Visions will be built by NCC on KTH campus in May 2015.



All design proposals that result from the Studio 4 course work will be exhibited in the Dome of Visions at the end of May. The exhibition will reopen 22 September, to inaugurate the winning pavilion (built inside the dome during the summer), as part of the Inspired by Space Conference at KTH.
