The Study abroad programme course packages are only open to recommended students at specific partner universities. If you have not been recommended your application will be refused.


Application period:

27 February 2025 - 13 March 2025.

How to apply

Go to the information webpage.

Click on the link for the courses for which you are going to apply. You will be redirected to <u>universityadmissions.se</u>. You will need to **create an account** to be able to apply.



Click create an account and follow the instructions. You will be asked if you have a Swedish personal ID number, answer **No**. You will be asked to enter your email address and select a password. Follow the instructions to create your account.

Once you have created your account and logged in please go back to the information webpage and click on the course links. They will redirect directly to the application. If asked to log in to your account do so.

When you have completed the application, you click "submit". Shortly after submitting your application, you will receive an e-mail from universityadmissions.se (no-reply) confirming receipt of your application. If you do not receive a confirmation e-mail, please log in again and check that the application was indeed submitted.

Documentation

Please upload ID documents and a transcript of records from your university to your application.

Status "late application"

Your application will be shown as being "late". Please **disregard** this, it has no impact on your admissions process.

Application fee

For your application to be processed you need to pay the application fee, 900 SEK. Please do so as soon as possible after making your application. Preferably pay by credit card. You will find instructions on:

Admission

Once the processing of you application is complete you will receive a **Notification of Selection Results**. This is legally valid as Letter of Admission from KTH. The Swedish Migratory Authorities accepts it.
