**Coming research founding will include standpoints of dual-use and if you don't comply, you are out**

Investors have previously been reluctant to invest in dual-use.  
Today, brand new funds have been opened, and traditional investors  
are open about MilTech being the focus area

**Knowledge of dual-use and the application creates trust, strengthens security, gives us opportunities for in-depth collaborations with the best in our field, and allows us to do things no one else does.**
