
Paint Room – Quick Guide

Purpose

This room is dedicated to **painting and spackling only**. **Sanding and dusty work are not permitted** to maintain a clean and high-quality finish.

Fire Safety

- **No sparks or open flames** are allowed.
- **Locate fire extinguishers** and other fire safety equipment before starting any work.

Ventilation

- Always **check that the ventilation system is functioning properly** before beginning work.
- If ventilation fails, **stop work immediately** and report the issue via the **bell at the workshop (A240)** or by emailing prototypassar@kth.se.
- Mark the equipment as **out of order** until it is fixed.

Personal Safety

Wear **safety goggles and gloves** to protect yourself from paint, solvents, and other chemicals.

Risk Awareness

Be mindful of potential hazards—such as **paint splashes to the eyes**—and always **read the product's safety data sheet** before using any paint or chemical.

Equipment and Storage

- The room includes **paint booths** for controlled work and a **chemical cabinet** for storing materials.
 - **Keep the cabinet door closed** at all times.
 - **Store all paints, spackle, and solvents** only in the designated cabinet—**not in corridors or other rooms**.
 - **Label your containers** with your name to prevent confusion.
 - **Empty containers** must be placed on the **bottom shelf** of the cabinet; discarding them elsewhere is a **safety violation**.
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
