Urban Ecosystem Services – Air, Water, Vegetation and Soils

When sustainable urban development is discussed, ecosystem services need to be taken into account. These could be provisioning services, such as materials and clean water, regulating services such as climate regulation and flood control, and supporting services such as soil formation, nutrient and water cycling and provision of habitat and recreation areas. For a sustainable urban development it will be necessary to integrate knowledge on ecosystem services in urban planning.

The seminar is organized by the Department of Land and Water Resources Engineering at KTH and is free of charge.
