Environmental objectives 2013 - 2015



- Reduce our energy consumption with 5%.
 - Improve our chemical management from an environmental and health point of view.
 - Reduce CO₂-emissions from business travelling with 10%.
 - Improve the procedures and environmental requirements in public procurements.
 - The highest environmental performance shall be achieved in constructions at the campus buildings.
 - Improve our waste management, to have better recycling procedures.

 - All programmes at KTH shall and comply with the legal requirement (Högskoleförordningen) for the learning outcome learning of environment and sustainable development.

 - KTH shall increase the visibility and improve cooperation with the society within the environment and sustainable development.
