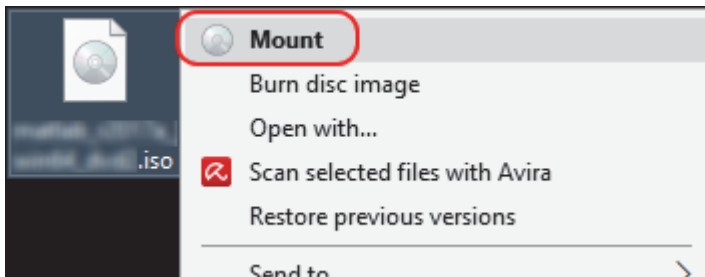


To access the files on an iso-image on Windows 8 and later versions of Windows you must first mount the iso-image.

If installing software with multiple iso-images, always make sure to unmount/eject the current iso-image, before mounting the next, to ensure that the next iso-image retains the same drive letter as the previous.

Here follows instruction on how to mount and unmount/eject an iso-image.

1. To mount an image simply right-click over the file and select **“Mount”**. This is equivalent to inserting a physical disk (CD/DVD/BD) or a USB-media. If there were no errors you will see a new drive letter in *“File Explorer”*.



2. The equivalent to ejecting a disc (or removing a USB-media) is to unmount the iso-image. To unmount the iso-image simply right-click over the drive letter in *“File Explorer”* and select **“Eject”**.
