Poster Guidelines

As the course memo says, you should upload the posters in the PDF format to your websites by January 5, 2015 at 9 AM. The poster should be formatted for A1 size and we will try to print them in the lab using multiple sheets of paper that you will then stitch together.

Each team member should be able to give a two minute presentation guided by the poster. The purpose of having a poster is to get someone interested in your work and you should be able to entice them in two minutes.

The poster should contain many of the elements from your project plan: the description of the problem and why it is important, what is the state of the art, what is your insight, high-level design (drawing) and a single evaluation graph in case you are measuring performance.

Keep your poster simple, there is absolutely no need to cram everything from your project into it. Remember to use very large font and be careful in how you use color (don't make an angry fruit salad as one Emacs package for syntax highlighting says). Reminder: don't put the KTH logo on the poster.
