Grading scheme and criteria for kexjobb assessment

For successful completion of the course students are required to get **all evaluation components approved.** Both oral and written oppositions/reviews need to be awarded G (godkänd/pass) whereas a <u>written report</u> accounts for <u>80%</u> and <u>oral presentation</u> for the remaining <u>20%</u> of the final grade.

In short, the formula for the final number of points (*Totalpoäng*) is

$$Totalpo\ddot{a}ng = 0.8 * RAP + 0.2 * PRES$$
,

where *RAP* is the total number of points obtained for a written report (max 54) and *PRES* for an oral presentation (max 32). The final grade is awarded based on the following table.

Evaluation of the written report and oral presentation

Written reports and presentations are evaluated using the evaluation forms available on the course website. They list criteria and the corresponding maximum number of points (max) awarded for their fulfilment. So, each criterion is assigned points from the interval 0 – max. The max should correspond to what can be considered the A standard for the given criterion and 0 corresponds to F (completely not fulfilled, absent etc.).

Two evaluations of each written report and how to understand scores in Rapp

Since there are two evaluators assigned to each written report, two versions of the total number of points (Totalpoäng1 and Totalpoäng2) are calculated from the formula (based on two RAP values, RAP1 and RAP2, and a single PRES). As a result two alternative grades (Betyg1 and Betyg2) are produced using the conversion table above, and in the case of any discrepancies the course examiner takes a final decision following a thorough additional scrutiny.
