

Goals

- A more open learning environment where assessment is not always supervised (by an invigilator/tentavakt)

Code of conduct (*uppförandekod*) for KTH students (2018)

KTH's goal is to offer you as a student a good education, as well as a good study environment from which you can obtain useful knowledge and experience for your professional life.

KTH therefore considers it of the utmost importance that you, during your studies, maintain a professional attitude to your studies, fellow students, teachers and other staff at KTH.



Code of conduct for KTH students

As a student at KTH, I agree to uphold the following:

- I consider all people to be of equal value. All students and staff at KTH have the same rights, opportunities and obligations, regardless of sex, transgender identity or expression, ethnicity, religion or other belief, disability, sexual orientation or age.
- Equal treatment at KTH implies a respectful and inclusive work and study environment free from harassment, sexual harassment, discrimination and offensive behaviour. I, like every student and employee, have a responsibility to treat others with respect in all meetings and to promote a secure and prejudice-free study and work environment.
- I will always lead by example and maintain a professional approach to all meetings and in all my communication. I treat all students, staff and other partners with respect and consideration, irrespective of their social background, sex, transgender identity or expression, ethnicity, religion or other belief, disability, sexual orientation or age.
- I am aware that discrimination, harassment, sexual harassment and victimisation, as well as any contravention of KTH's core values and guidelines, may be grounds for disciplinary action.



Code of honor (hederskodex) for students and teachers at CSC

It is in the interests of both teachers and students to maintain an open environment characterised by mutual trust. Both teachers and students contribute to the quest for knowledge in a positive academic spirit.

Education is intended to instill a professional work approach – including for instance *professional* integrity, understanding and acceptance of responsibility.



Code of honor for students...

Each student shall honestly declare the work that he/she has done and what he/she has not done. It is dishonest to copy texts or programming code. In certain circumstances, however, it can be appropriate to quote a certain authority. The student shall then clearly indicate what is a quote and the author. At other times it can be appropriate to use a complete program example, e.g. from the course literature. Any student doing this must openly declare it. It is wrong to acquire a previously completed solution to an assignment but it is permissible to use some help when in difficulties. Such help shall be openly acknowledged.



Ethical approach proposed heading in all course syllabuses at KTH


- For group work, everyone in the group has a shared responsibility for the work.
