

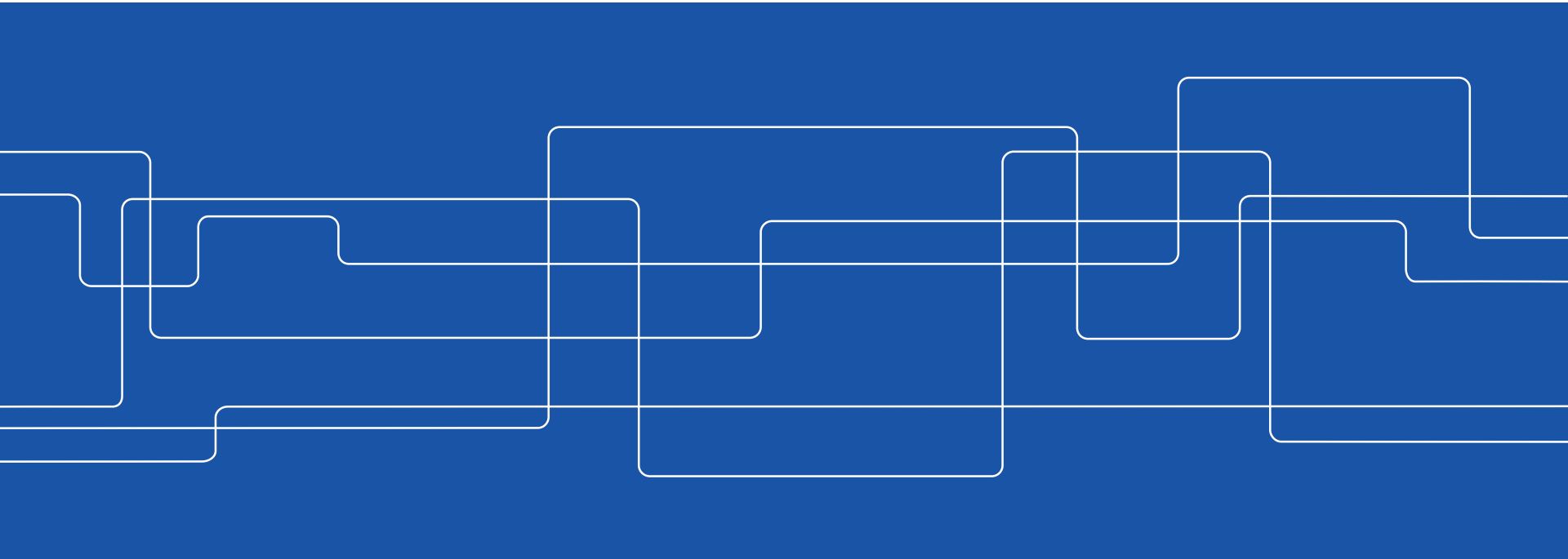

- 10 million inhabitants
- A monarchy
- Member of the EU
- Varied climate
- Home to many multinational companies
- Most Swedish people speak english





# Stockholm

- Capital of Sweden
- Biggest city in Sweden
- Home to 2.1 million people
- Around 85,000 students (24 universities)
- Built on 14 islands (24.000 in the archipelago) connected by 57 bridges





# KTH

- Established in 1827
- 13,000 full-time students
- 3700 full-time employees, 305 professors (46 women, 259 men)
- 5 schools
- Around one third of all students are from outside of Sweden

## Insurance:

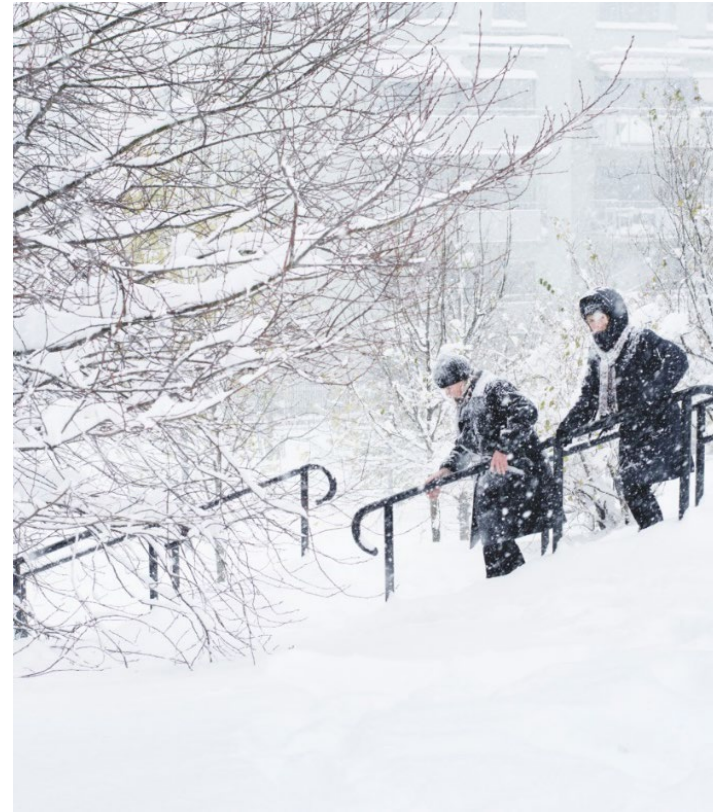
All students are insured via KTH on the school premises and during travel to and from these. Make sure you have sufficient medical insurance coverage.

# Covid-19 - Sweden

The Public Health Agency (Folkhälsomyndigheten) is responsible for Swedens actions to prevent spread of Covid-19.

- No gatherings over 50 persons in public places.
- Social distancing
- Wash your hands, sneeze and cough into your arm, avoid touching your face
- Stay at home if you feel sick
- If possible, avoid public transportation
- Call 1177 if you are experiencing any symptoms for further medical advice



# Covid-19 - KTH

- **Introduction period** for new students is being modified with more digital events.
- **Teaching** that would normally gather many students in one lecture hall is being modified with alternative formats, including digital and small-group teaching.

What to expect:

- **Service counters** separated with plexiglass barriers
- **Floor markings** showing where to stand for physical distancing
- **Signage** informing about capacity restrictions, displayed in print and digital formats throughout campus
- **Limitations on group sizes** will vary according to activities and settings
- **Designated seating for physical distance** in classrooms, labs and lecture halls
- **Hand sanitiser dispensers** in lecture rooms and all student areas
- **More frequent cleaning** and disinfection of interiors, including toilets, door handles and handrails

# Rights and Responsibilities

Disciplinary actions may be taken against students who:

For example:

1. try to mislead
  - by using aids during an examination that is not allowed
  - by plagiarizing someone else's essay/homework
  - by letting someone else add their name to an attendance list, despite not being present
2. act in a disruptive manner at the university
3. subject another student or employee at the university to harassment or sexual harassment

Examples of rights: student counseling, course evaluations, Student Union, ...

The KTH Code of Conduct clarify some of the expectations of you as a student at KTH. In short:

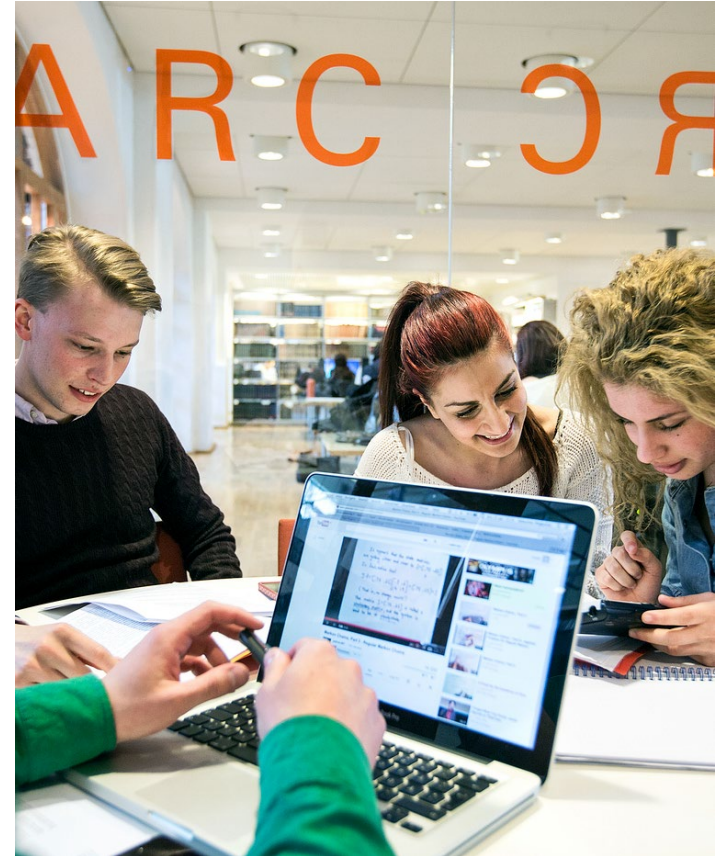




# KTH account
