Background

Maths Coach helps you with your homework and conducts research on homework tutoring. KTH Royal Institute of Technology is responsible for Maths Coach together with Linköping University and Chalmers University of Technology.

GDPR

We store information in a database to be able to improve Maths Coach. KTH collaborates with Smartera AB, who stores the database securely within the EU. We do not save any personal data because Maths Coach is anonymous. Voluntary information that we collect is what you need help with, grade or course, municipality, chat, whiteboard and a short survey that is sometimes used at the end of the conversation. If you and your coach use audio, the call will not be saved.

Why the coaches need information

The coaches use information about what you need help with and grade or course to give the student good help.

Why the project needs information

Maths Coach uses information about grade or course and municipality in order for the municipalities to receive information about how Maths Coach is used.

Why the research needs information

The research on Maths Coach uses information about grade or course, the chat, whiteboard and the survey to understand how homework help via the computer can be improved.

Responsibility for the research

The unit for Digital Learning, KTH is responsible for the research, together with Linköping University and Chalmers University of Technology.

Risk/harm

We see no risks with the research or conflicts for the researchers, as the chats are about discussing and solving mathematical problems.

Voluntariness

It is voluntary to participate in the research. You can choose not to participate in the research at any time by talking to your coach or contacting Maths Coach.

Informed consent

If you press the "I/we approve" button, it means that you have read and approved the text. If you are under 15 years of age, you and your guardians must read and approve the text. By clicking on "I/we approve" you jointly approve the text. If you or your guardians do not accept the text, you can not use Maths Coach.

We save a cookie on your computer to know that you/your guardians have approved this text.
