






What is MAS (master student representative)?

- Link between students and teachers, especially Programme Director (PA)
- Helps organizing and developing the program <u>from a student's view</u>
- Solves problems with courses, teachers and program anonymous if desired!
- Collects feedback on courses each period, presents to PA/MAS councils
- Usually 1-2 people, mixing swedish/international and first/second year students

Live in Sweden

- 1. If you are not from EU/Nordic union, you have to register at Migrationsverket
 - https://skatteverket.se/servicelankar/otherlanguages/inenglish.4.12815e4f14a62bc048f
 4edc.html
 - Visit the Tax Office
 - Get a personal number (YYMMDD-XXXX), which is required for almost everything (like a bank account, phone contract, ...)
 - Apply for an ID card, which is an approved form of identification within Sweden
 - Open your bank account if needed
- 2. Join the student union THS https://ths.kth.se/en/membership
- 3. Register for the housing queue (requires THS membership!): https://ths.kth.se/en/membership/housing-queue-sssb, www.sssb.se
- 4. Go out in nature while it's still summer winter is coming soon and it's getting dark ;-)



Learning Swedish

- KTH offers some Swedish courses check out if you can take them and if they count for your degree
- Tell people and friends to talk Swedish with you, otherwise Swedish people will talk to you in English
- KTH Språkcafé: https://www.kth.se/en/larande/sprak/sprakcafeer/i-olika-sprak-1.810522
 - Starts September 12th in the main library lobby
 - Swedish is offered on Wednesdays at lunchtime (12-13)
 - Possibility to learn other languages as well, e.g.:
 - > Monday: Japanese
 - > Thursday: German and Italian
- If not, English will work as well in Sweden



Living in Sweden (everyday advices)

- Take off your shoes if you enter someone's apartment
- Say "thank you" at least 154 times a day, otherwise you make a rude impression
- In Sweden, everyone is equal. There is no distinction between male/female etc
- Swedish people seem to be closed start talking with them and they'll turn out nice!
 - Talk about the weather, a very important topic in Sweden!
 - Work together, e.g. to learn for a course.
- The administration might seem to be ineffective and take a long time, but it will work out in the end
- Buy an SL monthly card, it's way cheaper than single rides if you commute daily
