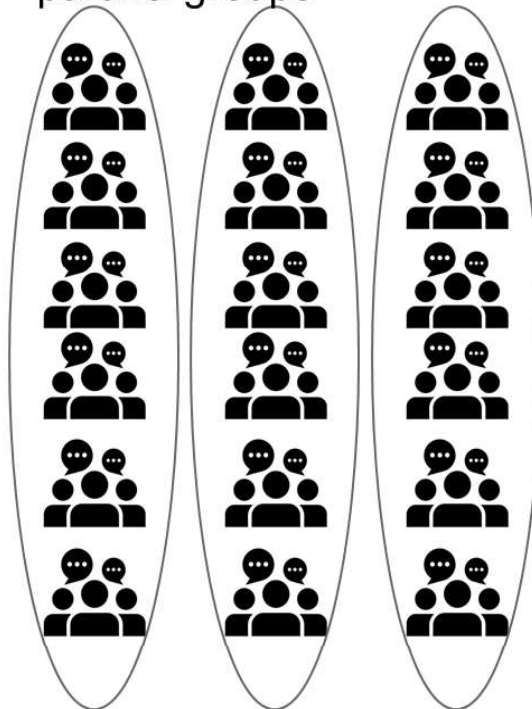


Storträffen every semester since 2016

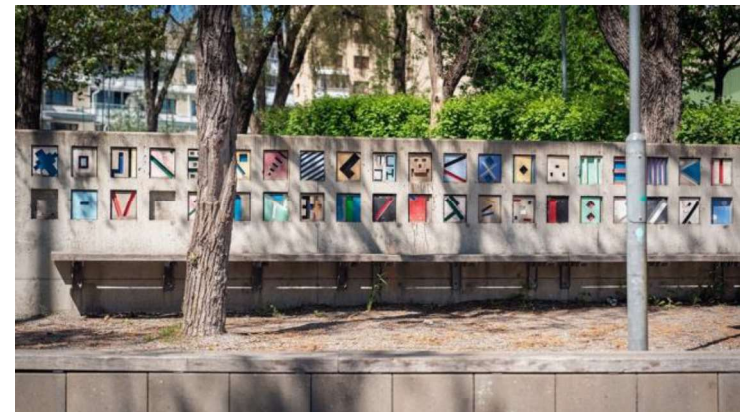
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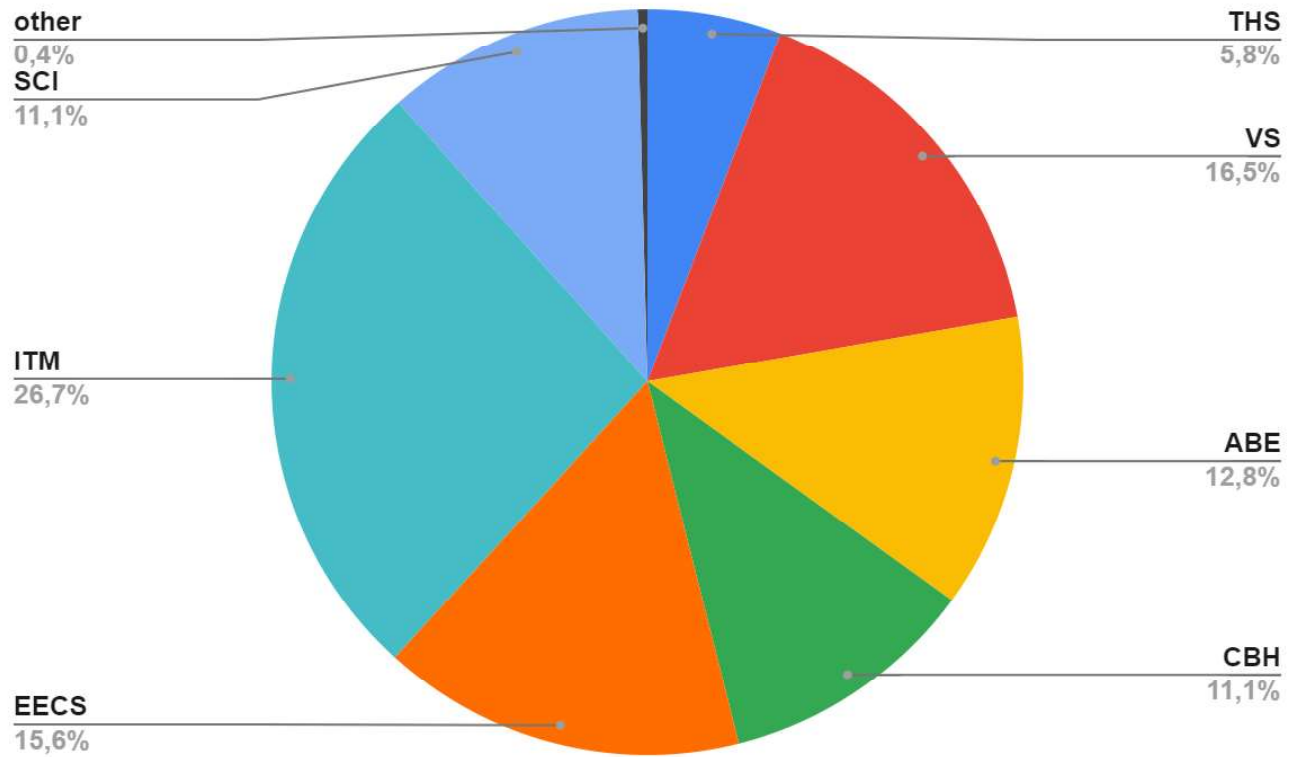
PRAO

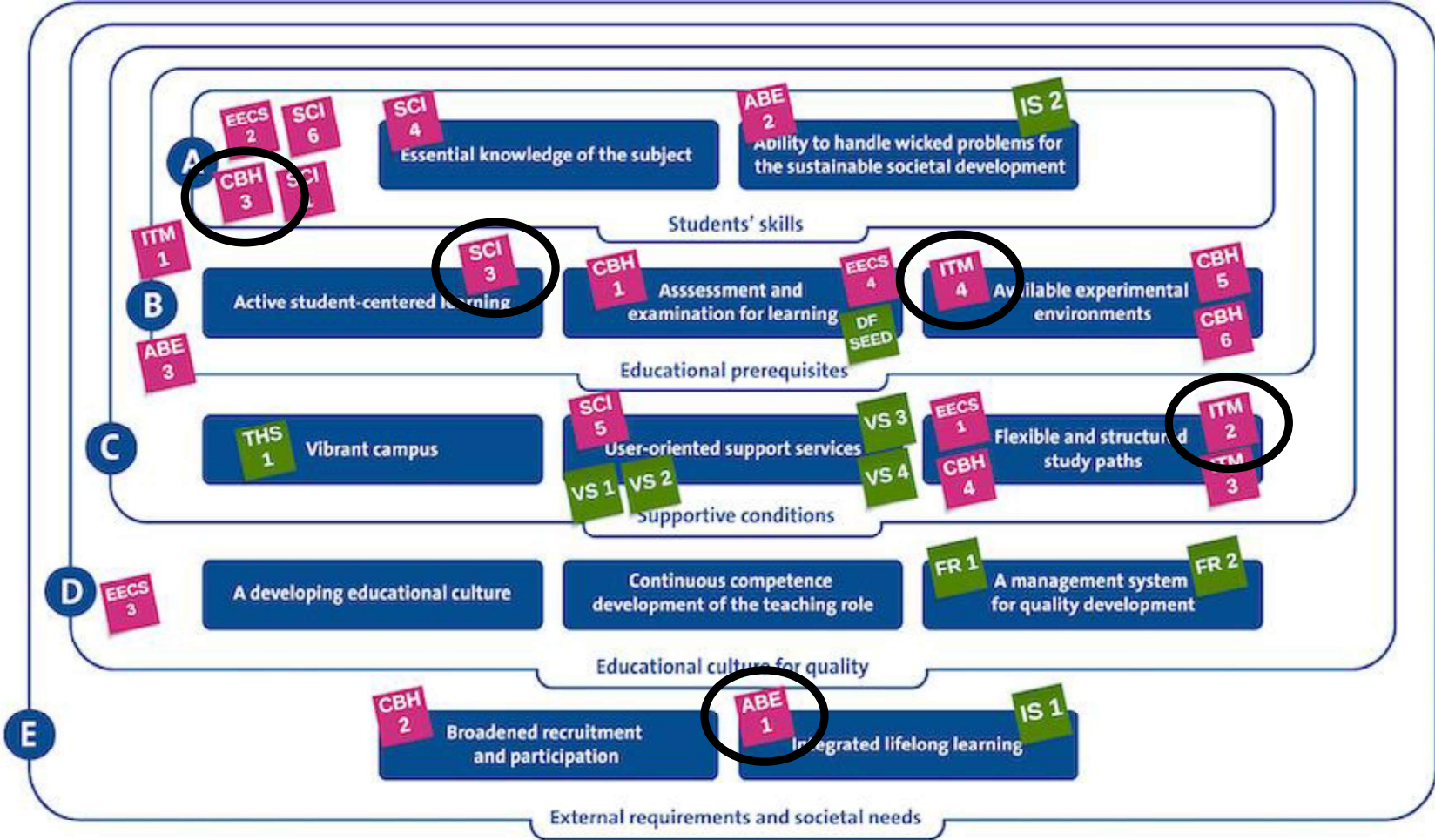


- **Set up the Program Organization**

 - Activities, coordination and knowledge sharing during fall 2023

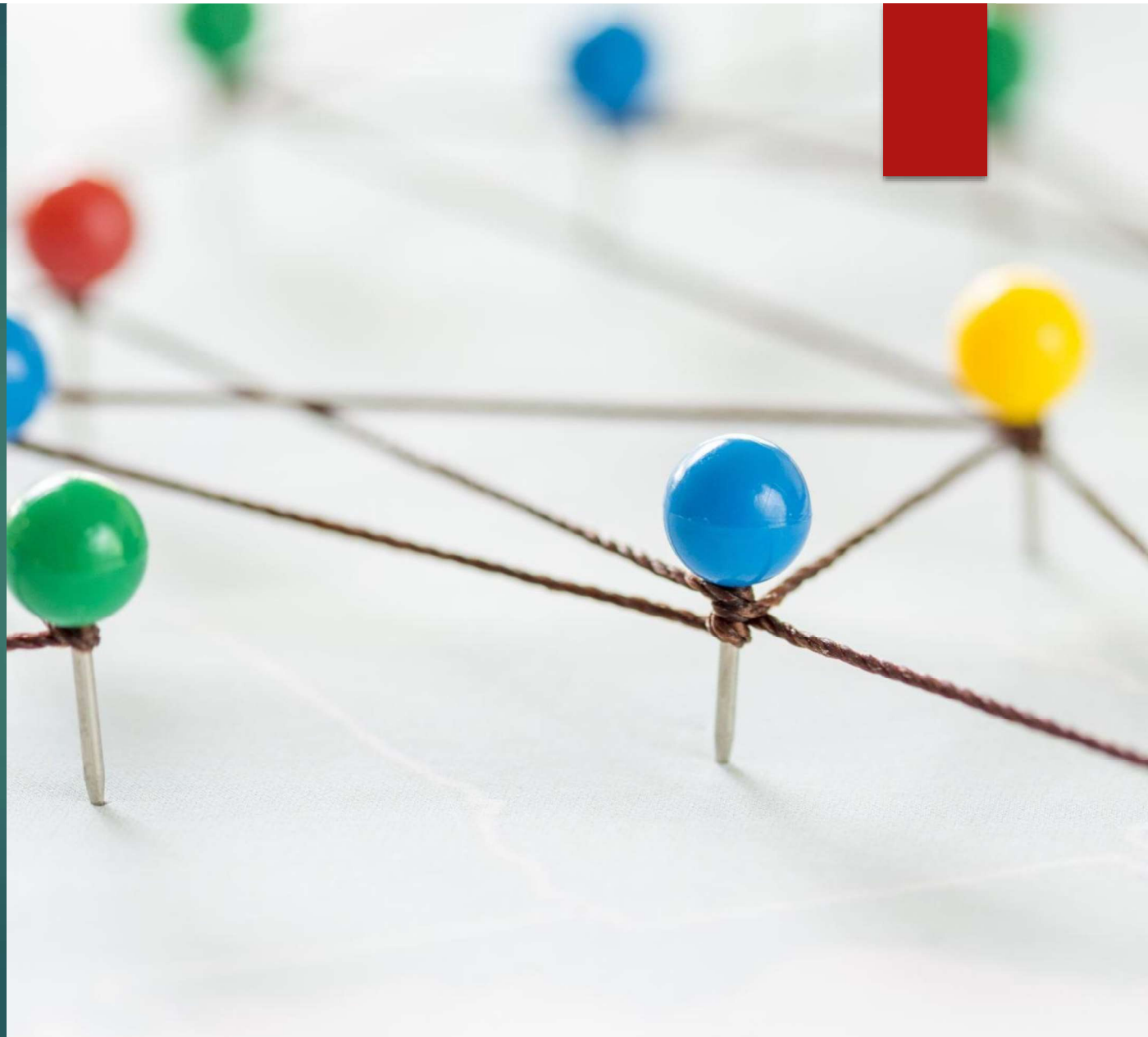

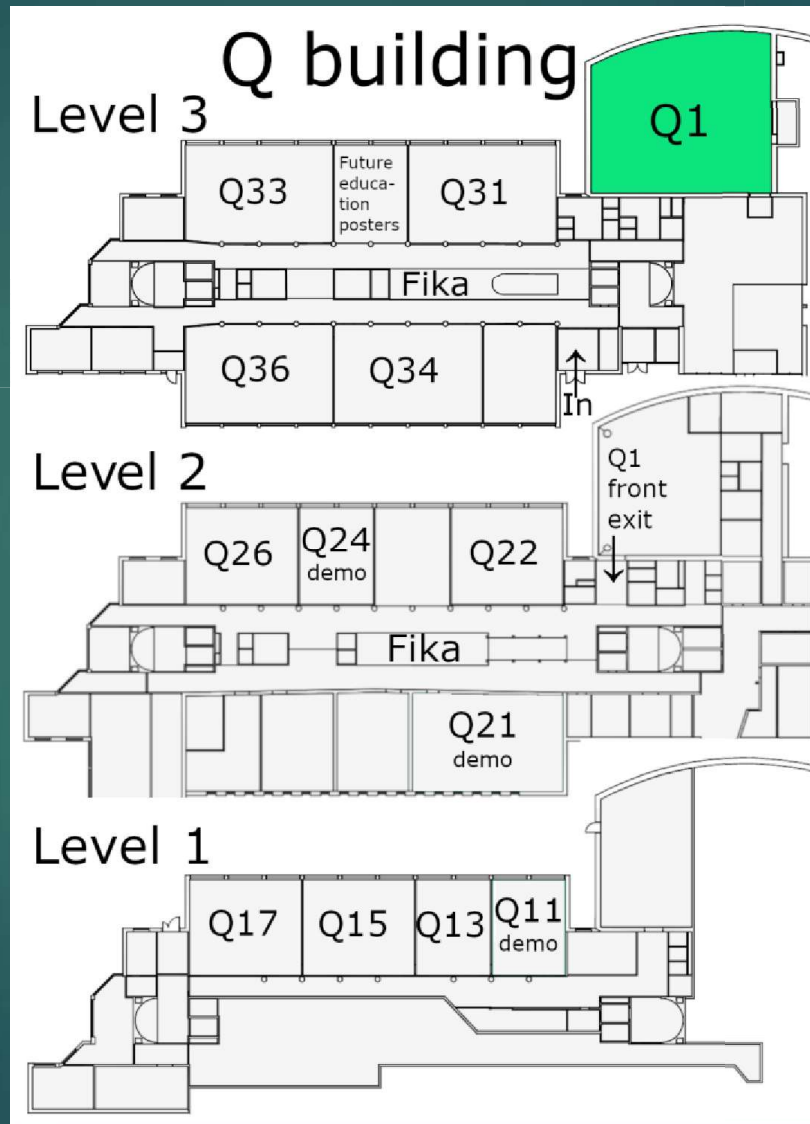
