Scope

3 credits correspond to 80 hours workload. In addition to the scheduled time you will do about 45 hours of work, in terms of literature and preparations for meetings, and a larger final assessment task.

Note! Register for the course only if you can attend the meetings and do the required work outside scheduled hours.

The course is designed for those who have co-supervised at least one doctoral student for at least a year.
