#### Scope

3 credits correspond to 80 hours workload. In addition to the scheduled time you will do about 45 hours of work, in terms of literature and preparations for meetings, and a larger final assessment task.

**Note! Register for the course only if you can attend the meetings and do the required work outside scheduled hours.**

**Who can take the course?**

The course is designed for those who have co-supervised at least one doctoral student for at least a year.
