Specific prerequisites

- At least 30 credits' university studies.

Language of instruction

The language of instruction is specified in the course offering information in the course catalogue.

Intended learning outcomes

The Fatale literary salon builds upon the idea that the staging of a friendly space creates a particular condition for critical reflection. The form of the conversation, the salon, corresponds to the content, feminist literary spaces. Each salon is structured around a specific theme – A room of one's own, Barricades, The White House, etc – and an attributed text, from which associations and spatial successions unfolds in different directions. Each salon takes place in different spaces related to the current theme.

Course contents

Disposition

The course is structured as a series of literary salons exploring and projecting feminist spaces. Each salon is arranged independently by the participants themselves working in groups of 2-4 students according to proposed themes and readings. The organising group sets everything up including choice of location, dress-code, refreshments etc.

Course literature

Course literature will be specified at the beginning of the course.

Examination

- MOM2 Active Participation 80%, spring semester, 2.5 credits, grading scale: P, F

Based on recommendation from KTH's coordinator for disabilities, the examiner will decide how to adapt an examination for students with documented disability.

The examiner may apply another examination format when re-examining individual students.

If the course is discontinued, students may request to be examined during the following two academic years.

Other requirements for final grade

MOM2 - Active Participation 80%, spring semester, 2.5 credits, grade scale: P, F

MOM3 - Assignment, 2.5 credits, grade scale: P, F

To obtain final grade, all three moments shall be passed.
