Specific prerequisites

Studies of at least 120 credits, Introduction to Swedish law 15 credits, and at least 6 credits within Real Estate Agency.

Intended learning outcomes

After passing the course, the student should be able to:

- Design and carry out an empirical commission of inquiry in real estate agency.

- Apply relevant knowledge in the subject area on a given problem
- Reflect on, evaluate and critically review their own and others' scientific results
- Document and present his work orally and written with requirements of structure, formalities and language.

Course contents

Main contents:

- Seminars and lectures around research method, literature search and report writing. Diagnostic work. Write a report that should be reported orally as well as a public discussion and examination of other authors' works. The work is made either individually or in groups of two. During the project work, a continuous supervision takes place.

Examination

- PRO1 - Project work, 15.0 credits, grading scale: P, F
- Based on recommendation from KTH's coordinator for disabilities, the examiner will decide how to adapt an examination for students with documented disability.
- The examiner may apply another examination format when re-examining individual students.
- If the course is discontinued, students may request to be examined during the following two academic years.

Ethical approach

- All members of a group are responsible for the group's work.
- In any assessment, every student shall honestly disclose any help received and sources used.
- In an oral assessment, every student shall be able to present and answer questions about the entire assignment and solution.
