Knowledge and understanding

- 1. Explain the development and sustainability of the real estate market in terms of function, financing, and management.
- 2. Describe the structure of the financial system, relevant actors, and the role in the urban planning and building process.
- 3. Explain the function of the financial system and its instruments concerning entrepreneurship and business operations.
- 4. Explain the fundamentals of real estate law and real estate development.

Skills and abilities

- 5. Demonstrate the ability to apply the theories, concepts, models, and methods covered in the course.
- 6. Locate, use, and evaluate different types of information sources and decision-making materials.
- 7. Write and orally present a well-structured and informative paper

Course contents

The course is an introduction to a number of important areas within real estate and finance; the role and function of the financial system, the real estate market, economics and capital investment appraisal.

The students will get practical experience of collecting and analyzing information in a scientific correct way in writing a written report.
