The language of instruction is specified in the course offering information in the course catalogue.

Intended learning outcomes

The aim of the course is to provide knowledge and understanding of the role of real property and property rights – in planning, change of land use and restrictions on land use.

Course contents

- Land and real property as a limited resource – balancing of interests
- The Swedish legal system regulating different rights to real property
- Legal rules governing the change of property boundaries in connection to change or restrictions of land use
- Land policy, land use and property structures from a historical perspective
