The purpose of the course is to enable the students to understand and explain legal actions necessary in land use transformations.

#### **Examination**

- INL1 Assignment, 0.5 credits, grading scale: P, F
- TEN1 Examination, 7.0 credits, grading scale: A, B, C, D, E, FX, F
