Intended learning outcomes

The purpose of this course is to provide basic principles as well as practical rules in the legislation governing compulsory purchase and compensation.

Course contents

Basic issues like legitimacy of compulsory purchase, principles and rules for compensation, different legal procedures to judge legitimacy and compensation, also seen in an international perspective. Swedish legislation such as the Expropriation Act, the Planning and Building Act and other relevant acts.
