Intended learning outcomes

After completed degree project, the student should be able to

- 5. demonstrate the ability to, orally and in writing, in dialogue with different groups clearly account for and discuss his/her conclusions and the knowledge and arguments underlying them
- 6. demonstrate the ability to make assessments considering relevant scientific, social and ethical aspects
- 7. show such skills that is required to participate in research and development or to work independently in other qualified activities

The degree project should constitute a specialisation within the field of the Built Environment The course is designed as a limited research project in the area of Real Estate.

The course structure include inter alia the following parts: Literature studies, problem formulation, collection and compilation of data, analysis, report writing oral presentation and public discussion.
