Intended learning outcomes

After completion of the Degree Project the student should be able to:

- 1. Apply knowledge and skills acquired during the studies on issues in biotechnology
- 2. Formulate and attack a technical problem by applying the relevant methodology
- 3. Identify the need for further knowledge and continually develop the skills through advanced studies in a specific field
- 4. Within the project framework, be able to independently analyse the raced issues and reflect on, evaluate and critically examine their own and others' results
- 5. Continuously documenting a work process
- 6. In a professional way present the work in writing and orally for a specific audience, calling for the structure, content, citation and referencing
- 7. Using basic concepts and tools for an active career start
- 8. Design a CV and a letter of application and be able to present themselves at job interviews
- 9. To explain the basics of technology-based entrepreneurship

Course contents

Most of the course is tied to a project task to be planned, performed, and presentation of interim and final reports according to a given curriculum. The task is formulated around the development of a production process for a specific product. The project involves a part focusing on a specific task. In support of the project work modules are included that develop professional communication, entrepreneurship and basic career planning.
