The language of instruction is specified in the course offering information in the course catalogue.

Intended learning outcomes

The goals of the course are to give the students

- knowledge about the use of net based systems for communication
- knowledge about storytelling and communication with video

so that they will be able to

- combine media elements to produce a sense of presence as a basis for trust and good communication.

Course contents

Lectures, local and distance, and demonstrations; Storytelling; Integration of PC, CD-ROM, video, internet, video mixing, keying etc.

Examination

- PRO1 - Project, 6.0 credits, grading scale: A, B, C, D, E, FX, F
