After completing the course, the student should be able to:

Listening comprehension

- understand the content of clear standard speech on general subject areas/events. (level B1)

Reading comprehension

- understand and give an accurate account of authentic texts dealing with topical issues on technical subjects and working life. (level B2)

Speaking

- converse and discuss informally on topics of personal interest or related to studies, work or topical events. (level B1)
- orally summarise texts of a general and/or specialist nature (level B1/B2)
- give an individually prepared oral presentation of a specialised nature (level B1/B2)

Writing

- summarise texts of a general and/or specialised nature (level B1/B2)
- write a factual report or an expository/argumentation text (level B1/B2).

Course contents

Oral proficiency:

- Pronunciation, intonation, fluency
- Discussions in French, listening comprehension, oral proficiency.
- Summaries of general and technical texts, presentations, speeches

Written proficiency:

- Free writing in French
- Report writing, summaries of general and technical character

Disposition

56 lesson divided into 14 sessions x 4 lessons

Examination

- ANN1 - Examination, 3.0 credits, grading scale: A, B, C, D, E, FX, F
- ANN2 - Examination, 3.0 credits, grading scale: A, B, C, D, E, FX, F
- TEN1 - Language Proficiency, 3.0 credits, grading scale: A, B, C, D, E, FX, F

Based on recommendation from KTH's coordinator for disabilities, the examiner will decide how to adapt an examination for students with documented disability.

The examiner may apply another examination format when re-examining individual students.

During the course, the students also take four minor midterm tests/quizzes. The combined result of the two tests is converted to a point score which is added to the student's score on the TEN1 exam.

Other requirements for final grade

75% attendance. Oral and written examinations (ANN1; 3 credits and ANN2; 3 credits), language proficiency, TEN1; 3 credits)
