Intended learning outcomes

The overall aim of the course is for the student to be able to use English as the main language in working life with a high degree of professionalism, variety and subtlety.

On completing the course, the student should be able to:

- actively understand and use low-frequency words in English
- adapt his/her language use to the communicative situation
- distinguish implicit meanings in the language which may be context-dependent
- convey ideas and opinions in situations (such as meetings and negotiations) encountered in working life
- using correct, varied and appropriate language, give an individually prepared oral presentation on a specialised subject
- present arguments in a large group on topical issues
- write formal reports, e-mails and letters, and essays on topics of a specialised nature.

Course contents

Oral proficiency:

- Pronunciation, intonation, fluency
- The language and techniques of meetings, debates and presentations
- Negotiating and problem-solving through role play

Written proficiency:

• Writing reports, proposals, summaries, minutes, formal letters and CVs

Examination
