## Course contents

Both the contents and course organization will be determined upon the start of the course, and that will depend on the time, the research orientation of the students, as well as the coming seminar series.

## Examination

Based on recommendation from KTH's coordinator for disabilities, the examiner will decide how to adapt an examination for students with documented disability.

The examiner may apply another examination format when re-examining individual students.

These will be determined upon the start of the course and will consist of two main parts: A project report/presentation and documented participation in a specified seminar series.

## Ethical approach

- In an oral assessment, every student shall be able to present and answer questions about the entire assignment and solution.
