Language of instruction

The language of instruction is specified in the course offering information in the course catalogue.

Intended learning outcomes

For the research student after the course to be able to account for, discuss and analyse secondary literature well known to historians of technology.

Course contents

Historiography in the History of Technology, Technological determinism, Economic historians' perspective on history of technology, Tools of imperialism, Education of engineers and engineering competence, Technology and gender, Science and Technology, Social constructivism, General histories of technology and overviews, Technology and politics, Technology and war, Technology and culture.

Course literature

Anglosaxon secondary literature in the form of articles, monographs and overviews, which will be announced at the start.

Examination

Based on recommendation from KTH's coordinator for disabilities, the examiner will decide how to adapt an examination for students with documented disability.

The examiner may apply another examination format when re-examining individual students.

Other requirements for final grade

Active participation in seminars and written examination in the form of an independent study relying on perspectives supplied by the course literature.
