Course contents

A selection of research papers and other scientific literature, approved by the examiner and supervisor.

Examination

Based on recommendation from KTH's coordinator for disabilities, the examiner will decide how to adapt an examination for students with documented disability.

The examiner may apply another examination format when re-examining individual students.

Other requirements for final grade

Written examination in the form of a paper/essay and/or oral examination, per decision of the examiner.
