Specific prerequisites

Enrollment in doctoral program, having done ones literature review or equivalent.

Language of instruction

The language of instruction is specified in the course offering information in the course catalogue.

Intended learning outcomes

The course helps doctoral students to situate themselves in the broad field of transport science. The students obtain broad knowledge through overview lectures and interact on more detailed topics in seminars, taking various roles (presenter, opponent, listener).

Course contents

Overview lectures covering the broad field of transport science. Participation in scientific seminars offered at the department of transport science. Participation in national and international conferences.
