Language of instruction

The language of instruction is specified in the course offering information in the course catalogue.

Intended learning outcomes

The course aims to be published in scientific journal.

Course contents

During the seminars, the strategies for getting published will be covered. These concerns range from how theory and empirical linked to the choice of journal. The course is based very much on the discussions during the workshops, and the participants and the course leader's experience.

Disposition

The seminars will take the form of collective seminars and individual meetings between the instructor and the working group, or individual students.

Examination
