### Intended learning outcomes

Specific, detailed learning outcomes are agreed between the PhD student and the examiner before the start of the course.

#### Course contents

Literature studies within a defined topic, as agreed between the PhD student and the examiner before the start of the course.

#### Course literature

The literature is agreed between the PhD student and the examiner.

#### **Examination**
