Specific prerequisites

Enrolled as PhD student

Language of instruction

The language of instruction is specified in the course offering information in the course catalogue.

Intended learning outcomes

The participants should gain experience in presenting their own research. Taking part in discussions related to both own and others research plans is also emphasized.

Course contents

Seminars by the students where they explain the background of their research project and discuss recent results.

Disposition

The participants will meet once a week and listen to two seminars given by two different PhD-students.

Ca 20 occasions per semester. A full course involves two semesters.

Examination

Based on recommendation from KTH's coordinator for disabilities, the examiner will decide how to adapt an examination for students with documented disability.

The examiner may apply another examination format when re-examining individual students.

Other requirements for final grade

The students should give three seminars each and are obliged to participate at 80% of the scheduled occasions.

Ethical approach

- All members of a group are responsible for the group's work.
- In any assessment, every student shall honestly disclose any help received and sources used.
- In an oral assessment, every student shall be able to present and answer questions about the entire assignment and solution.
