Language of instruction

The language of instruction is specified in the course offering information in the course catalogue.

Intended learning outcomes

When completing the course, the student should be able to present scientific and technical material to both general and specialized audiences in a logical and comprehensible manner.

Course contents

Seminars, individually assigned.

Disposition

At least four own seminars shall be given; of which at least one should be a broad overview of the student's research topic or alternatively a popular science lecture to a general audience; and at least two should be on specific parts of the PhD project. In addition, the student shall attend at least four seminars given by other students and provide feedback on their presentations.

Course literature

Individually assigned.

Examination

Based on recommendation from KTH's coordinator for disabilities, the examiner will decide how to adapt an examination for students with documented disability.

The examiner may apply another examination format when re-examining individual students.

Other requirements for final grade

At least four own seminars shall be given; of which at least one should be a broad overview of the student's research topic or alternatively a popular science lecture to a general audience; and at least two should be on specific parts of the PhD project. In addition, the student shall attend at least four seminars given by other students and provide feedback on their presentations.
