To be enrolled as graduate student in Materials Science and Engineering, directed towards Corrosion Science.

## Intended learning outcomes

To gain experience in completing a literature survey in the field of corrosion science.

#### **Course contents**

Collect literature and analyze results in order to complete a corrosion-related literature survey in collaboration with an industry or other organization.

#### **Course literature**

Selected after consultation with the course coordinator.

#### Examination

Based on recommendation from KTH's coordinator for disabilities, the examiner will decide how to adapt an examination for students with documented disability.

The examiner may apply another examination format when re-examining individual students.

## Other requirements for final grade

The literature is presented as a report, which must not be part of the doctoral thesis.
