## Intended learning outcomes

By the completion of this course participants will have established a literature base and theoretical framework in a subject area of relevance to the field of Industrial Engineering and Management. The literature survey produced for the Examination cannot be included in the final PhD thesis to more than 20%.

## Course contents

The specific content and the subject area is decided in relation to the subject area of the planned thesis of individual PhD-student.

## Disposition

The basic premises are individual literature studies. The course format is however tailored to fit the needs of the individual students.

The course is given in English.

## Course literature

Literature equivalent to at least 800 pages. Information on literature included is given at course start.

## Examination

Based on recommendation from KTH's coordinator for disabilities, the examiner will decide how to adapt an examination for students with documented disability.

The examiner may apply another examination format when re-examining individual students.

Hand in of a written literature survey reflecting the course material
