Intended learning outcomes

The course intends to provide:

- Knowledge of the fundamental physical principles for the electrical properties of living cells.

- Mathematical models describing membrane and action potentials
- An introduction to electrophysiological measurement techniques.

Course contents

Seminars:

The course is given as a series of seminars where the participants take an active role. The topics to be discussed: cellular electrical potential, mechanisms generating electrical potential, action potentials, model descriptions, the cable model, the Hodgkin-Huxley model, neuronal cells, voltage gated ion channels.

Laboratory exercise:

Electrophysiological measurement of membrane potential.
