Intended learning outcomes

After passing the course, the student must be able to:

- calculate and measure electrical quantities in direct and alternating current circuits

- realize solutions to control engineering problems using PLC and microprocessor

- Electric machines
- Sensors
- OP amplifier
- Digital circuits

- Simple control systems, PLC and microcontrollers

Examination

- LAB2 - Laborations and assignments, 4.5 credits, grading scale: A, B, C, D, E, FX, F
