Specific prerequisites

At least 210 credits, including at least 30 credits in the major area of industrial management and organization must be completed before thesis work begins.

Language of instruction

The language of instruction is specified in the course offering information in the course catalogue.

Intended learning outcomes

To independently carry out investigative work on a scientific basis and present it in an essay. Work will be based on knowledge in the area and develop new knowledge through scientific theories and methods.

Course contents

Ongoing guidance, a series of seminars. The student must cooperate with the company and link that the experience with the academic world. Discussions with supervisors in individual sessions and seminars.

Examination

- PRO1 - Project, - credits, grading scale: P, F
- XUP1 - Exam, 15.0 credits, grading scale: A, B, C, D, E, FX, F
