Language of instruction

The language of instruction is specified in the course offering information in the course catalogue.

Intended learning outcomes

The course is a project oriented advanced course in industrial ecology. The aim is to provide – through some smaller projects – deeper knowledge in industrial ecology.

After a passed course the student should be able to independently collect information from scientific literature and other information sources in industrial ecology, make a compilation of this information, and analyse it in a written report.

Course contents

The course is a project oriented advanced course in industrial ecology. The aim is to provide – through some smaller projects – deeper knowledge in industrial ecology.

Course literature

The course is a project oriented course - the literature depends on the selected projects.

Examination

- PRO2 - Project Work 2, 3.0 credits, grading scale: P, F
- PRO1 - Project Work 1, 3.0 credits, grading scale: P, F
- PRO3 - Project Work 3, 3.0 credits, grading scale: P, F
