Main field of study

Physics, Technology

Specific prerequisites

Students attending the master of science programme in Engineering Physics (5 years).

Language of instruction

The language of instruction is specified in the course offering information in the course catalogue.

Intended learning outcomes

The goal is to complete courses so that they may be included in the students degree.

Course contents

Parts of compulsory courses from the first three years of the programme in Engineering Physics.

Course literature

Decided individually.

Examination

- INL1 - Assignment, 4.5 credits, grading scale: P, F

If the course is discontinued, students may request to be examined during the following two academic years.

Other requirements for final grade
